To Suit: TOYOTA LANDCRUISER HZJ 75/78 SERIES 4.2 DIESEL (1HZ Engine)

- Fitment to: Right hand side
- **Fitting time:** Approximately 120 minutes
- Special Tools: 89mm Holesaw Step Drill Touch-up Paint Air Hacksaw Loctite 243 (thread lock)

Prior to commencing the installation, it is the installer's responsibility to verify that all components and particularly the template (Item 12) are correct.

Instructions:

- 1. Remove: Air cleaner assembly Standard air entry ducting Fuel filter assemblies Landcruiser badge
- 2. Tape the template to the rear edge of the guard and the extended part of the template to the top edge of the guard. Using a felt tip pen, mark all hole positions, remove template.

3. Drill a pilot hole for each hole position. Using the step drill, drill the 4 snorkel mounting hole positions to 16mm. Using the 89mm holesaw, drill the 2 main hole positions. Mark a straight line top and bottom of the holes. Using the air hacksaw, cut away the remaining pieces of the panel. Deburr and paint holes.

NEW ZEALAND INSTALLATIONS ONLY :

Safari have developed 2 methods of Snorkel A pillar attachment, for the conventional method please proceed with the current document alternatively please see the link below for further instructions. www.safari4x4.co.nz/apillarmounting

- 4. Install the upper mounting bracket (item 3) to the snorkel body (item 1) with hex bolts (item 4). Apply Loctite 243 to each of the stainless steel mounting studs (item 7) and install the studs finger tight into the snorkel body (item 1) mounting inserts.
- 5. Carefully position the snorkel body onto the guard. With the snorkel body correctly positioned onto the guard, mark the 3 upper mounting bracket hole positions on the 'A' pillar. Remove the snorkel body.
- 6. Drill the 3 marked holes on the 'A' pillar to 8mm, deburr and paint holes. Insert plastic body clips (item 6) into the 'A' pillar.
- 7. Position snorkel body onto the guard. With the snorkel body correctly positioned, fasten using necessary hardware. Fasten the upper mounting bracket to the 'A' pillar.
- 8. Position hose clamp (item 10) onto the snorkel body snout. With the hose clamp in position install air entry hose (item 11) to the snorkel body snout (a small amount of lubricant may be required at each end of the hose to ensure easy fitment). With the hose correctly positioned fasten the hose clamp.
- 9. Re-install fuel filter assemblies and air cleaner assembly to the vehicle. Fasten the air entry hose to air cleaner using the standard hose clamp.
- 10. Install air ram assembly to the snorkel body and fasten.

N.B: It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that all connections are watertight.
